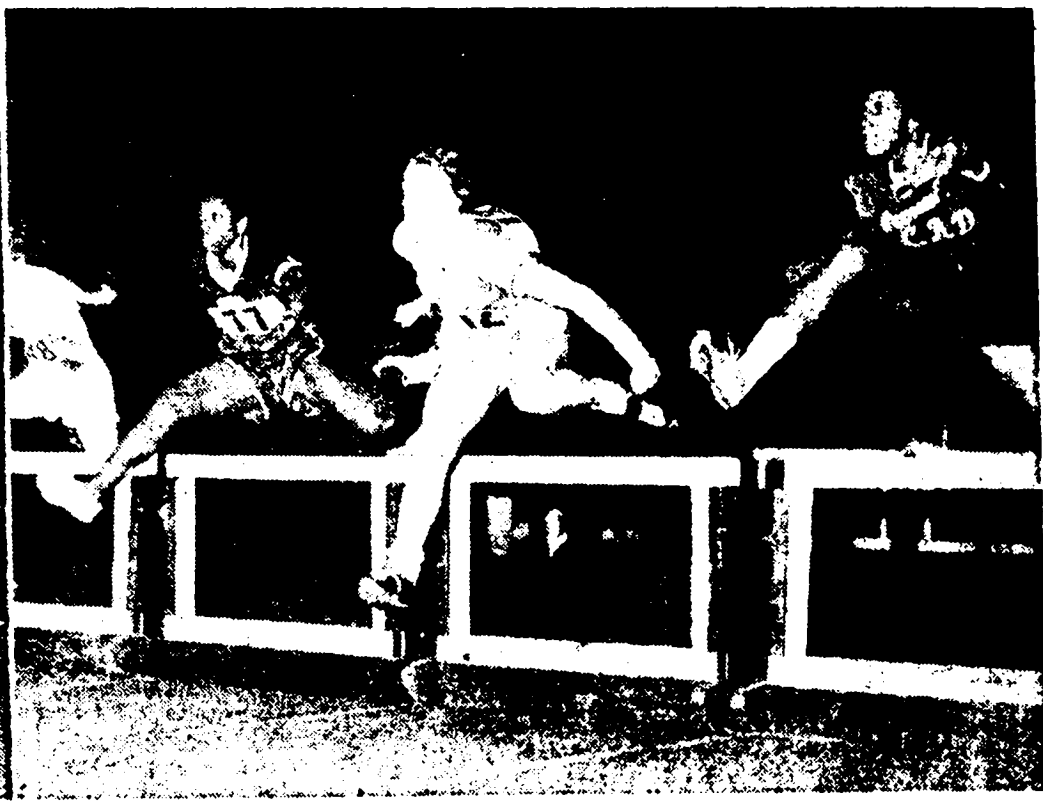


Records Topple In NAAU Meet

iors. Miss Terry won the event setting a new mark of 9.5. The Tennessee Tigerbells won the senior women's team title with a total of 49
