

TO PREVENT REGISTRATION FRAUDS.

Republicans Arrange to Watch Proceedings Today in the First and Second Wards.

The Republican committee on detection and prevention of frauds in registration and at the polls completed extensive arrangements last evening for watching registration in the First and Second Wards today.
