

Postal Employees To Crack Bias Line

WASHINGTON — Ashby Carter, president of the National Alliance of Postal Employees, this week announced the intention of his organization to conduct a determined drive "to crack the Hindenberg Line" of prejudice and discrimination in the U. S. Postal Service.

The NAPE president, recently returned from a tour of the Southeastern States, declared that the Alliance has laid down a program designed to eliminate the flagrant and numerous practices of racial discrimination uncovered and investigated during his trip.

Forecasting hardship for minority group workers during the predicted recession, Mr. Carter declared:

"The organization must and will gird itself for the coming struggle ahead to protect the gains made and to achieve additional advances.
