## Heroines Elect Officers

Champaign, Ill., Nov. 28.—Prince Hall Grand Guild, Heroines of the Templar Crusades for Illinois and its jurisdiction, was instituted Tuesday, November 11, in the Masonic Temple, Champaign, Ill. The work of organizing the new Grand body was performed by Mrs. Fannie G. W. McDonald of St. Louis, Mo., grand princess captain of the United Grand Guild of Missouri, and Sir A. A. Henderson of Chicago, right eminent grand commander of Prince Hall Grand Commandery, Knights Templar of Illinois. Representatives were present from the guilds at Champaign, Chicago, Galesburg, Des Moines, Iowa, Rock Island and East St. Louis. During the noon hour the members of the new grand guild were taken on an automobile ride through the university grounds and over the Twin Cities, as the guests of Grand Commander Henderson.
